SERVICE AGREEMENT

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) requires that water supplies have an agreement with every water customer that allows the supplier to check the customer's system for possible cross connections between the customer's private lines and the public water system. A cross connection is a connection that may allow contamination to enter the public water system from the private system. Potential contamination must be prevented from entering the public system by either installing and annually testing a TCEQ approved back-flow device or utilizing a 6" air gap. Additionally, use of lead pipe (greater than 8%) or solder/flux containing more than 0.2% lead is prohibited. By signing this agreement, you are authorizing City officials to inspect your plumbing for possible cross connections. In the event a cross connection is located, the customer must immediately correct the problem with one of the methods mentioned above to prevent termination of service. Your cooperation in helping us maintain safe drinking water for you and your neighbors is greatly appreciated.
